Information about local salt bins, salt bags and salt use

Lifton Parish Council is a member of the Devon County Council snow warden scheme, which provides the parish with a supply of rock salt.

DCC provide salt bins around the village for use by residents during periods of cold weather.

Additional bins and salt bags are provided by the Parish Council to ensure that most areas of the village have access to salt when required.

Please find below their locations:

DCC Salt Bins - Top of Darkey Lane, Parkwood Rise x2, Duntz Hill, Park Road and Hannaford Road.

PC Bins - Parsonage Court, Village Shop and Primary School car park (North Road).

Salt Bags - Arundell Close, The Crescent, Leat Road, Liftondown (by the bus shelter), and New Road (entrance/pathway to primary school).

Local residents can use salt on public highways and pavements during cold weather conditions. Residents are **not** permitted to use the salt on private driveways or paths or on private business/commercial properties.

Please use the salt during periods of cold or severe weather only; and remember a little can go a long way.
