

Winter Road Salting – Lifton Parish Update

Devon County Council salts primary routes first whenever ice or snow is forecast. This includes the main road through the village (Old A30 Liftondown to Sourton).

Secondary routes are treated only during prolonged or severe weather, typically the road from Lifton/Tinhay to Tavistock via Chillaton.

Most smaller parish roads are not routinely salted, so please take extra care in cold conditions.

Footpaths:

DCC does not routinely salt pavements. Grit bins are provided for community use on some public paths during icy weather.

Grit Bins:

Grit bins are located at Park Road, Hannaford Road, Parsonage Court, Parkwood Rise, Top of Darkey Lane, Fore Street (outside village shop), Lifton School layby.

They are intended for:

- Public footpaths
- Steep or hazardous spots
- Community use during icy conditions.

They are not for private driveways or commercial premises.

Please use grit responsibly (sparingly).
