

Lifton Parish Council Meeting – 26th February 2026
Agenda item 6.2 – Highways Update

The following notices/issues have been reported to or from Devon County Council Highways since the last meeting, as follows:

W261950225 - Pothole, Pothole (Single or multiple). Location: Road from Stone Cross to Westend Cottages, Lifton. Thank you for taking the time to submit this report. What action has been taken? A repair is due to be undertaken, or has already been undertaken, at the location you provided.

W261956996 - Pothole, Pothole (Single or multiple). Location: Fore Street, Lifton. Further to your communication received on 18-February-2026 the record was assessed on the 19/02/2026. The following information is now available: Further to receiving your report on 18 Feb 2026, we are writing to let you know that it has been reviewed and has been passed to our contractor for either further investigation or to be repaired. We expect this to be completed by 26 Feb 2026. Once completed, we will provide you with a further update to let you know what action has been taken.

Other matters raised:

Stone wall (Fore Street) – The Clerk has tried to pass on a concern raised (via Cllr Edmonds) by a local resident in relation to the stone wall on Fore Street (opposite Lifton Stores & Post Office). Land Registry titles detail that the wall is not owned by Lifton PC.

The Clerk has contacted both National Highways (Highways England) and DCC Highways. The matter of ownership and responsibility is still not clear between these two authorities. An update will be provided at the PC meeting.

Funding for VAS solar panel conversion kit – Councillors received a quote from Elan City Ltd., at the PC meeting held in December, for a solar panel kit to convert the battery-operated VAS (£521.08 inc. VAT & delivery). Councillors will be asked to consider moving forward with placing an order.
